2 Samuel 17, Jeremiah 21, Romans 7|8



The fruit of your doings

For Yahweh had appointed to defeat the good counsel of Ahithophel, to the intent that Yahweh might bring evil upon Absalom. (2Sa 17:14). Yahweh was merciful to David as Barzillai the Gileadite, brought forth fruit, providing “to eat: for they said, The people is hungry, and weary, and thirsty, in the wilderness”. (2Sa 17:27-29)

Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I set before you the way of life, and the way of death. (Jer 21:8). But I will punish you according to the fruit of your doings, saith Yahweh: and I will kindle a fire in the forest thereof, and it shall devour all things round about it. (Jer 21:14)

Yahweh desires fruit, “ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; even to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God. (Rom 7:4). For I know that in me dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not. (7:18) For I delight in the law of God after the inward man: (7:22). I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin. (7:24-25). That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, ...; as to be spiritually minded is life and peace (R8:4-6). For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. ...and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together. For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. (8:14-18). And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. (8:28). They, “which have the firstfruits of the groan, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body. (8:23), which is the fruit of all creation, finally given to the glory of God.
