KING of the NORTH

SELEUCUS (I) Nicator (312-281 BC)

ANTIOCHUS (I) Soter (281-261 BC)

ANTIOCHUS (II) THEOS (261-246 BC)

Poisoned by Laodice (first wife) who then killed Berenice and her son

SELEUCUS (II) CALLINICUS (246-226 B.C)

SELEUCUS (III) CERAUNUS (226-223 BC)

ANTIOCHUS (III) the GREAT (223-187 BC)

218 BC Attacked Ptolemy (IV)

198 BC Conquers Palestine and Syria

192 BC Attacks the Greeks

190 BC Defeated at Thermopylae
Huge war indemnity to Rome
His daughter Cleopatra supports her husband Ptolemy Epiphanes

187 BC He is murdered while robbing a temple

SELEUCUS (IV) PHILOPATOR (187-175 BC)

Raised high taxes to pay Rome
Poisoned.

ANTIOCHUS (IV) EPIPHANES (175-163 BC)

170 BC High Priest Onias murdered.

169 BC Attacks Egypt. Treaty. 168 BC attacks Ptolemy (VIII) to re-instate Ptolemy (VI). Victorious but stopped by Rome. Attacks Jerusalem. Forbids Law observance. Statue of Jupiter Olympus. Profanes Temple. Hellenistic Jews cooperate.

167-166 BC. Maccabee uprising
Jerusalem freed.

250 252 BC His daughter Berenice married to Antiochus Theos

PTOLOMY (III) EVERGETES
(246-221 BC)

235 245 BC. Defeats Seleucus (III) Callinicus

PTOLOMY (IV) PHILOPATER
(221-205 BC)

215

217 BC. Defeated Antiochus (II) Theos at Raphia.

210

205 Entered Temple at Jerusalem, stricken and died.

200

PTOLOMY (V) EPIPHANES
(205-180 BC)

195

190

193 BC Married Cleopatra (I) daughter of Antiochus (II) the Great.

185

PTOLOMY (VI) PHILOMETOR
(180-145 BC)

175

He marries his sister Cleopatra (II)

170

170 BC. He attacks Antiochus (IV) his mother's brother; is defeated.

165

Ptolemy VI and VIII (brothers) cooperate.

160

Rome re-instates Ptolemy (VI), who dies in 145 BC

155

150

The infant Ptolemy (VII) is murdered by Ptolemy (VIII)
