2 Samuel 13, Jeremiah 17, Matthew 28



## **I Yahweh search the heart and give to every man according his ways**

Jonadab was a very subtil man and he is the agency to bring the beginning of David's troubles due to his way, in the matter of Amnon, Tamar and Absalom.

“Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from Yahweh... Blessed is the man that trusteth in Yahweh, and whose hope Yahweh is. For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, neither shall cease from yielding fruit”. (Jer 17:5-8). “The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it? I Yahweh search the heart, I try the reins, even to give every man according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings” (17:9-10). A glorious high throne from the beginning is the place of our sanctuary. O Yahweh, the hope of Israel, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, and they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken Yahweh, the fountain of living waters. Heal me, O Yahweh, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise. (17:12-14) As for me, I have not hastened from being a pastor to follow thee: neither have I desired the woeful day; thou knowest: that which came out of my lips was right before thee. Be not a terror unto me: thou art my hope in the day of evil. Let them be confounded that persecute me, but let not me be confounded: (17:16-18).

Yeshua the pastor was healed and delivered from death, rewarded according to his way, “All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them... Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen” (Mat 28:18-20). Yeshua is given power to search the heart.
