1 Samuel 19, Isaiah 63, Matthew 8



The Spirit of Yahweh caused him to rest

David escapes from Saul to Samuel. All those sent to take David have the Spirit of God come upon them and they prophesy, even Saul, “the Spirit of God was upon him also, and he went on, and prophesied..before Samuel in like manner, and lay down naked all that day and all that night. Wherefore they say, Is Saul also among the prophets?” (1Sa 19:23-24).

Who is this that cometh from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? this that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save. (Isa 63:1) And I will tread down the people in mine anger, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth. (Isa 63:6) I will mention the lovingkindnesses of the LORD, and the praises of the LORD, according to all that the LORD hath bestowed on us, and the great goodness toward the house of Israel, which he hath bestowed on them according to his mercies, and according to the multitude of his lovingkindnesses. (Isa 63:7) Then he remembered the days of old, Moses, and his people, saying, Where is he that brought them up out of the sea with the shepherd of his flock? where is he that put his holy Spirit within him? (Isa 63:11) The Spirit of Yahweh caused him to rest: so didst thou lead thy people, to make thyself a glorious name. (Isa 63:14)

Yeshua leads. The centurion understood the power saying “for I am a man under authority”. In faithin the Spirit Yeshua calms the sea. He said unto them, “Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith?” Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm. But the men marvelled, saying, What manner of man is this, that even the winds and the sea obey him! (Mat 8:27). He then cures the men with the evil spirit casting it into swine, to give him rest.
