2 Chronicles 23, Daniel 4, Acts 2



Most High Rules in the Kingdom of Men

Jehoiada the High Priest who remained faithful and defied Athaliah bringing up Joash in secret to be king, shows that God rules, “Jehoiada made a covenant between him, and between all the people, and between the king, that they should be the LORD'S people. (2Ch 23:16)

Nebuchadnezzar the king, unto all people, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth; Peace be multiplied unto you. I thought it good to shew the signs and wonders that the high God hath wrought toward me. (Dan 4:1-2). His heart was changed from man's and a beast's heart be given unto him for his pride that he had built Babylon; and seven times passed over him as: “This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.”(Dan 4:16-17). Restored Nebuchadnezzar says of the Most High, “He doeth according to his will none can stay his hand.”(Dan 4:35)

Dwelling at Jerusalem were Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven...they were all amazed and marvelled, saying, “Behold, are not all these which speak Galilaeans? How hear we every man in our own tongue? (Act 2:5,7-8) Peter shows the doubters of Israel that God rules, not them, “Ye men of Israel; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know: Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain: Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it(Act 2:22-24). For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, 'The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, Until I make thy foes thy footstool. (Act 2:34-35) The Base chosen by God rule until then.
